

Governor must quit soon:Goynche Mogi

PANJIM, JAN 29 — Goynche Niz Mogi on Thursday demanded the immediate resignation of Governor S C Jamir on moral grounds stating that he was equally responsible for passing the Regional Plan 2011 and all hill-cuttings around Goa.

Addressing a press conference in the city, President of GNM, James Fernandes said, "In his address to the assembly, Jamir pointed that Goans have a distinct image." If he believes in this unique image, how could he concur to the passing of the GRP, CRZ violations, hill cuttings, sale of forest and agricultural land to invincible buyers?, he questioned.

James further said that the resignation of Governor on the grounds that 40 elected representatives were perpetuating the greatest fraud on Goans would awaken Goans to reality that all political parties are like the same old wine labelled as BJP, Congress,

MGP, NCP, UGDP and Janata Party.
